


- 1. Felt: black, brown, light-blue, light-orange, purple, red, tan, yellow and white
- 2. Good all-purpose glue or craft fabric bonding glue (works best!)
- 3. Markers, fine-point: black and other colors you want
- 4. Scissors, Needle & Thread

LION:


- 1. Cut out **BODY** and glue on **MANE**
- 2. Glue on FACE, FRONT LEG and BACK LEG
- 3. Glue on **MUZZLE** and **TOES**
- 4. Glue TUFT to tip of tail
- 5. Glue on each EYE PATCH, TONGUE and NOSE
- 6. Glue on each EYE
- 7. Draw the eyelid and pupil on each $\ensuremath{\text{EYE}}$
- 8. Draw the smile and whisker dots



For head & reflection, cut 2 of all head parts.



2. Add lion's head as reflection
